

Last Wednesday (03/04) for our Midweek Service we ascended Mt. Carmel. On Mt. Carmel, the prophet Elijah summoned Israel and the 450 prophets of Baal. On this mountain it was time for the Israelites to turn back from their evil ways of worshipping foreign gods and worship the true God of Israel. The true God was revealed in the raining of fire on a sacrifice on the altar to consume the sacrifice through the prayers of prophet Elijah.
