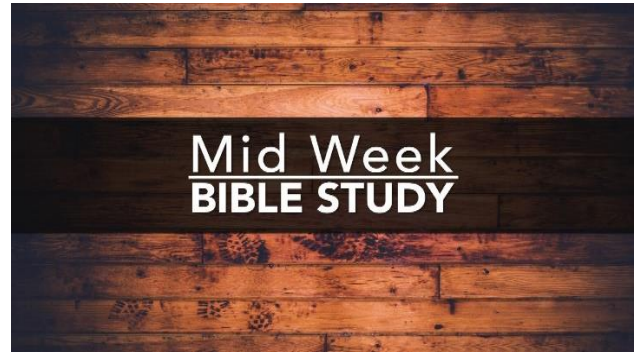

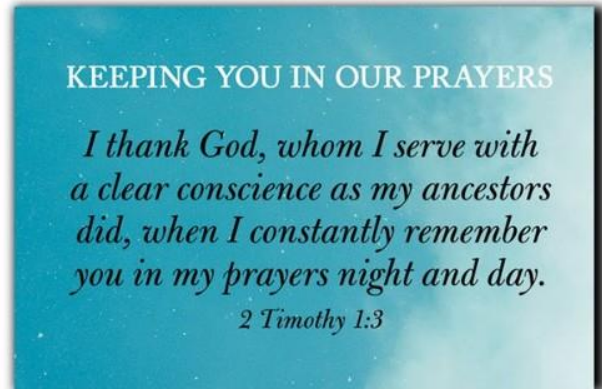
WE ARE STARTING A KID'S CHOIR

“Doctor: Do you exercise? Me: Yes. I have walked with the Lord for the last 20 years.”

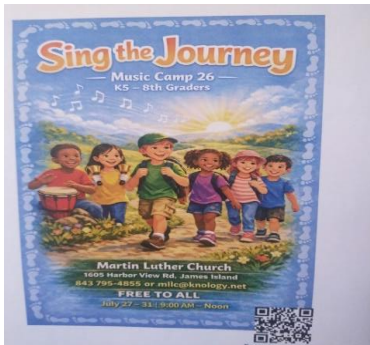
“Don’t you hate when you joking and somebody come on your post all serious...That’s the person NOBODY wanted to play with growing up.”
