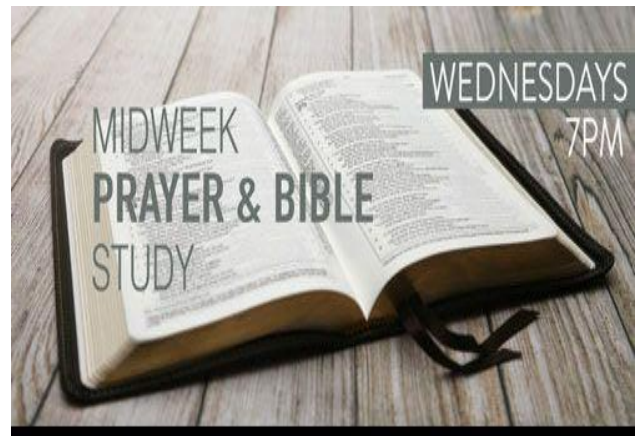


JANUARY 6th was The Epiphany of Our Lord. This coming Sunday (01/25/26) is the Third Sunday after The Epiphany of Our Lord.

Abraham and Abimelek (King of Gerar)

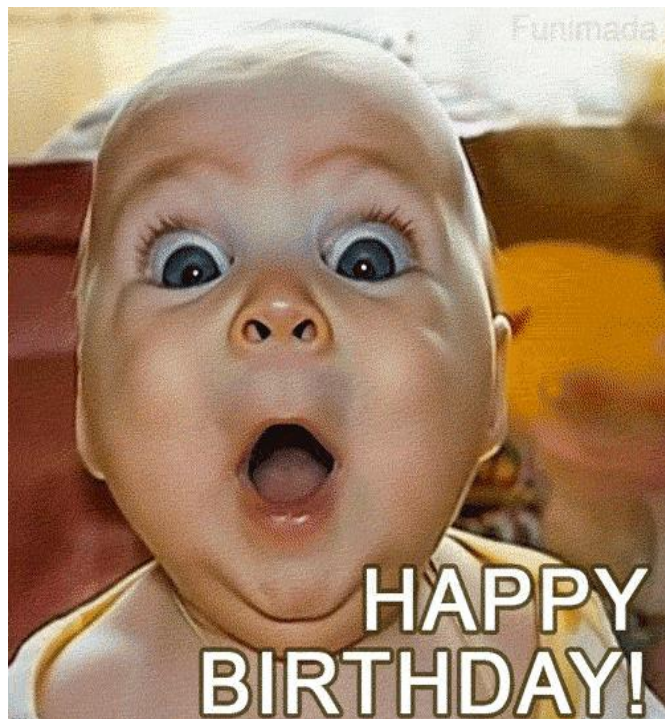
Genesis 21:
